Information about the boats

You have two different boats to choose between, with guides on both of them. The M/F Annaskär is open-decked and has no facilities. Aboard M/S Gåsefjärden you can choose to sit outside or inside and there is a basic range of refreshments for sale. Toilet facilities are also available onboard M/S Gåsefjärden.

It is possible to take a wheelchair on board the M/F Gåsefjärden. The number of seats is limited, please contact Affärsverken for further information on phone 0455-783 30.

Ticket Prices

If you are departing from Fisktorget, you buy your ticket at the information kiosk. At all other piers, you purchase your ticket when you board the boat. You can pay by credit card, Swish, or cash (SEK or EURO). Remember to keep hold of your all-day ticket, which you'll have to show every time you jump on board. With it you can also travel on the bus in central Karlskrona.

The Summer Card is Valid

Blekingetrafikens Summer Card (Sommarkort) is valid on board. If you are departing from Fisktorget, collect your ticket at the information kiosk before you board. At all other piers, show your Summer Card when boarding. The Summer Card costs 695 SEK and is valid on all trains, buses and boats in Blekinge between June 15 – August 18. 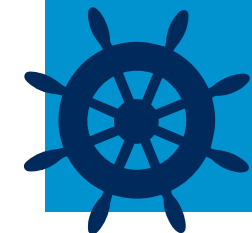

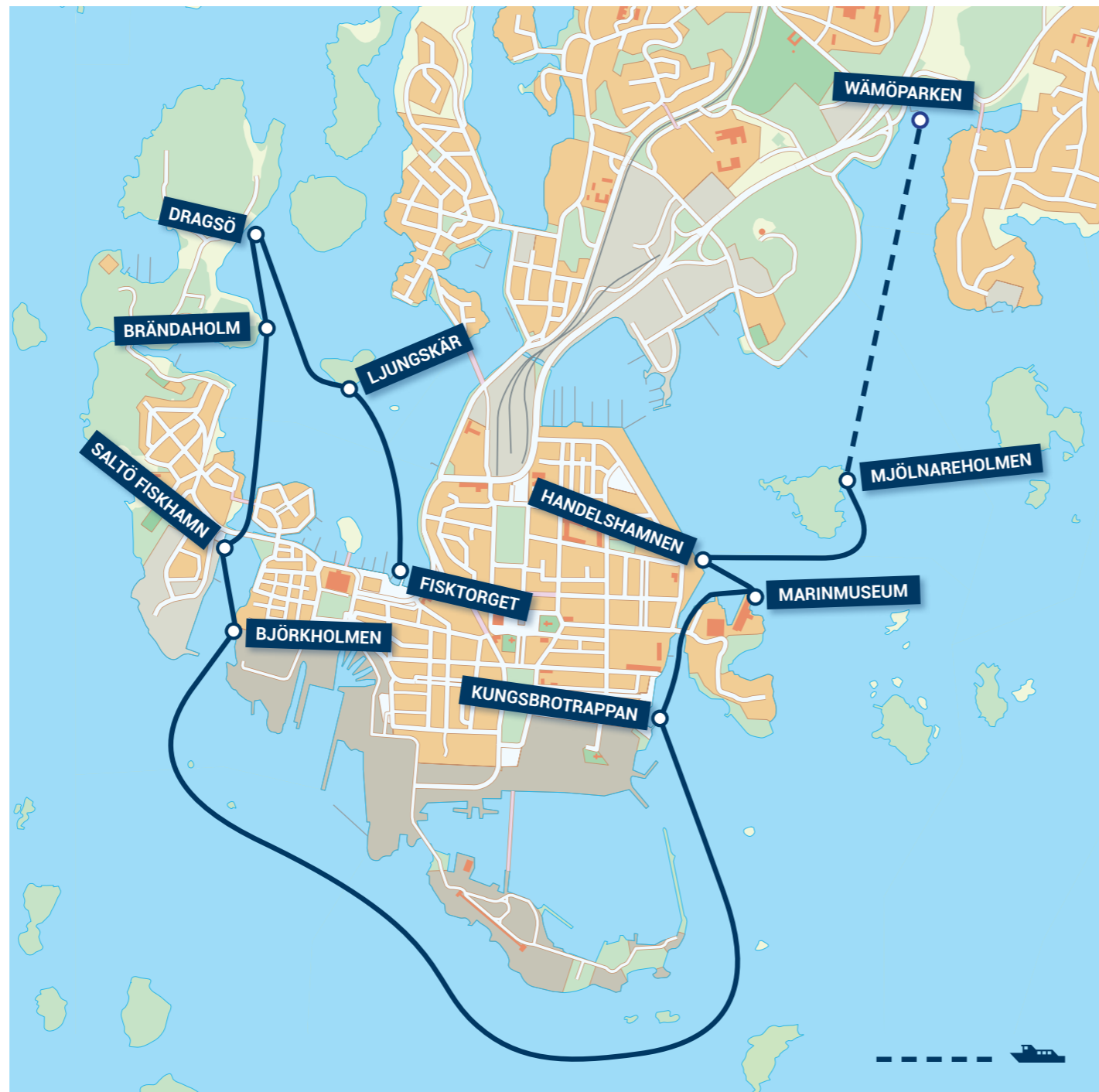

Semaforen
Some piers have a semaphore. Hoist it to show that you wish to come aboard.



Fisktorget 🍴 🚶 🏰 The hub for excursions in the Karlskrona archipelago. Just a few steps from the city centre, where the unique history of a World Heritage Site meets excitement and street life. From here, you have easy access to Blekinge Museum.

Ljungskär 🏰 🌊 Construction of the Powder House began in 1734. The building served as a powder magazine and fortress tower. Today, Ljungskär is like a little secret oasis where you can swim, barbecue and explore the island on your own.

Dragö 🍴 🚶 🏰 This island features boat & kayak rentals, adventure golf, swimming, a playground, hiking trails, a restaurant, a kiosk, and a café. The city's most central campground is also located on the island.

Brändaholm 🏰 Scenic Brändaholm is a real summer paradise and one of Sweden's most photographed postcard-perfect places. The area was built in the 1920s, and in order to be allowed to own a cottage here, you must be registered in Karlskrona and promise to maintain the island's appearance and charm.



Saltö Fiskhamn 🍴 🚶 At Saltö, you can stroll around the harbour and enjoy fresh fish and delicious seafood in an authentic environment. About 300 metres from the pier, you'll find Saltö Beach with its diving tower, sandy beach and rocky bathing areas.

Björkholmen 🏰 🌊 🏰 Was erected in the early 1700's and is one of the oldest districts in the city. Here you can stroll through history, wandering along alleyways named after types of ships and famous admirals. Björkholmen is now part of the Karlskrona World Heritage Site and most of it is protected by cultural preservation laws.

Kungsbrottrappan 🏰 Karlskrona's grand gateway to the sea. Many royal people have disembarked here, and the site clearly marks the boundary between civil and military life. On one side lies the Bastion Aurora inner fortification; on the other side is the County Residence, where the County Governor lives.

Marinmuseum 🍴 🚶 🏰 🌊 The Naval Museum is Karlskrona's biggest tourist destination. Here you can explore the exciting history of the Swedish Navy in a different way – take a tour inside a real Cold War-era submarine, visit the museum boat, or allow your love of play to get the better of you up on "Dunder's Deck".

Handelshamnen 🍴 🚶 From this commercial port, you can travel by ferry to Aspö, take the shuttle to Sturkö, or easily continue further into the mainland. Take a stroll along the quay to Karlskrona Stadsmarina, have a coffee or take a look at Karlskrona Porcelain Museum and Albinsson & Sjöbergs Car museum.



Mjölneholmen 🌊 🏰 🌊 Sunbathe on the roof of a bunker, look for beetles, and watch seagulls and ferries or stroll from east to west. In the centre of the island you will find a 300 year-old defensive tower once used to store gunpowder. Evenings in July you may experience summer theatre on the island.

Wämöparken 🏰 🚶 The park opened in 1910 and its style reflects the national romantic spirit of the era. Its attractions include lovely walks, barbecue areas, a mini zoo with Swedish farm animals, a playground, an agility course for four-legged friends, a dance hall and more.
